

**Minutes of the Ordinary meeting of Full Council
(FC) held at the Gate, Pentre Road, St Clears on
Tuesday, 17th October 2023 at 7.00pm**

Members Summoned and Present: Cllrs Dr WEVJDavies, GADavies (Mayor), RGEwards, OGrant, FLanc, JMiller, TMcDermott, JRees, PJRogers, IThomas-Wigley.

In attendance: Press (0), Members of the public (1), Carmarthenshire County Councillors (0)

520. **Apologies. RESOLVED to accept apologies from** Cllrs CMDavies and IPrice.

521. **Personal Matters.** The Mayor expressed that the Council's thoughts and prayers are with Cllr CMDavies at this time and extended a speedy recovery to Cllr IPrice.

522. **Declarations of Interest.**

523. **To confirm the minutes of the Ordinary meeting of the Full Town Council (FC) held on 19th September 2023.** Cllr RGEwards proposed, and Cllr PJRogers seconded the motion that the minutes of the Ordinary meeting of the Full Town Council (FC) held on 19th September 2023 be resolved as an accurate account of proceedings. **RESOLVED that the minutes of the Ordinary meeting of the Full Town Council (FC) held on 19th September 2023 be adopted as an accurate account.**

7:31hrs Cllr OGrant joined the meeting in person following being on Zoom for the beginning of the meeting.

524. **Matters arising (exchange of information only).**

Item 479 point 5, The Gate - The Gate lease is still pending, and a vast amount of the Ten Towns grant application hinges on a successful transfer. A lot of time and work has gone in to preparing the grant application and to lose the opportunity at this late stage due to this delay would be very disappointing for the town. As such, Council proposed that a face-to-face meeting with officers of Carmarthenshire County Council be arranged, to work through all the outstanding issues and revisit the agreement, finances, dates etc. Town Council have managed the day to day running and incurred costs for the facility since July 2023. However, delays with the lease have meant that Town Council has not been able to generate any income because of these delays. Cllr PJRogers proposed, and Cllr JMiller seconded the motion that a letter be sent to Carmarthenshire County Council officers (including Head of Legal and

the County Council representatives) to ascertain what the delays were and to request a face-to-face meeting to address outstanding issues and to commence establishing the steering committee. **RESOLVED that the Clerk and Mayor contact Carmarthenshire County Council to ascertain what is the cause of the continued delay with the lease transfer and to request a face-to-face meeting.**

525. **To receive the County Councillor's Update.** Apologies received from County Cllrs PHughes and CJones.
526. **To receive an update on the Ten Towns Capital Grant application.** The Mayor led on this and informed Council that the Revenue grant application had been submitted. The outcome of the application should be known by mid to end of November 2023. The Capital grant application was near completion and needed approval prior to submission and before the end of October 2023. This included:
- professional works for tender by Harold Metcalf Associates for improvements to the internal layout of the Gate
 - new furniture for key areas
 - digital screens at the Gate and main town carpark for better online presence and communication, which includes a new website.
 - Street art (two main displays). Permissions has been sought and approved from business owners. Art works tendered from three different artists. Successful applicant 'Jenks Art'.
 - St Clears is part of Sustrans; therefore, the application includes improvements to cycle tourism, e-bikes, a bike maintenance station plus bike lockers within the town.
- The mayor thanked the sub-group for all their hard work. The question was raised, why no improvements were included for Bancyfelin, which is part St Clears ward. **NOTED.** The grant is not for the ward but part of the County Council's Ten Towns grant. As such, the funds may only be spent on improvements within St Clears town. St Clears town Council acknowledged that when considering and planning for future projects that the Twon Council would use Council funds plus others available to also benefit Bancyfelin and other areas within the ward. Cllr PJRogers proposed, and Cllr JRees seconded the motion that the Capital grant application be submitted. **RESOLVED to submit the Ten Towns capital grant application.**
527. **To consider recommencing the Warm Space (Croeso Cynnes) until the café is up and running.** Council considered recommencing the Warm Space initiative as it was evident that there was a wellbeing need within the town and that several individuals were ready to assist with the volunteering. Cllr JRees proposed, and Cllr PJRogers seconded the motion to recommence the Warm Space in principle but only after the outstanding issues with the Gate lease, commencement date and cleaning had been addressed. **RESOLVED to**

recommence the Warm Space in principle once the outstanding issues with the Gate (lease, cleaning, proposed date etc) had been addressed.

528. **To consider future projects (funded by Town Council or grants), with a named Councillor responsible for the research and costings.** Council considered some ideas. Namely, playparks at both Welfare field, St Clears and Bancyfelin, increase number of benches (seating in and around town), Community fridge, foodbank, and 'Bocs Bwyd' initiatives. Community garden and green space initiative in collaboration with Wales West Housing and Griffith Jones school. The purchase of Poodogs sculptures made from recycled materials to encourage dog owners to clean after their pooch. **RESOLVED to defer matters to the Environment and Community, Finance and General -Purpose committees for consideration and draw up a 5year priority plan with costings and named Councillors responsible for researching each project. Members to send their ideas to the clerk for distribution prior to the November committee meetings.** It was noted how refreshing it was to hear consideration given to additional future projects being discussed for the area over and above what the Town Council already undertake.
529. **To consider setting up an Environmental Volunteers Group.** Town Council considered setting up an environmental volunteers' group to support the Town Council's Biodiversity plan, and wildflower seeding and litter picking. Insurance for the project would cost in the region of £70 per year. Cllr Dr WEVJDavies proposed and Cllr IThomas-Wigley seconded the motion that the Environment Committee set up an Environment Volunteers Group that has a constitution and approved volunteers list. **RESOLVED that the Environment Committee set up an Environment Volunteers Group that has a constitution and approved volunteers list.**
530. **To approve the sub-committee reports**
- a) Environment committee. Members requested that the x4 planters be sited as soon as possible. Cllr GREdwards proposed, and Cllr PJRogers seconded the motion that the Environment Committee Minutes be approved as a true record of proceedings. **RESOLVED to adopt the Environment report as a true record of proceedings.**
 - b) Community, Finance and General-Purpose committee. Town Council wished to consider an alternative Christmas gift in future thus reducing plastic waste and being more sustainable. Cllr WEVJDavies proposed, and Cllr OGrant seconded the motion that the Community, Finance and General-Purpose Committee minutes be approved as a true record of proceedings. **RESOLVED to adopt the Community, Finance and General Purpose minutes as a true record of proceedings.**
